ANTI-RAGGING AWARENESS PROGRAMME

EVENT DETAILS



The 'Anti-ragging' awareness programme was organized by the Anti-ragging committee on 14th of August 2025 for the students, which was skilfully executed by the student council. The programme was organized with the aim of creating awareness about anti-ragging among the students.

The awareness was created through various activities like poster making, slogan writing, street play and flash mob on the the theme of ragging which were later posted on social media platforms and the institution website to create awareness.





A short film about ragging, its effects and preventions was screened during the programme to give students practical examples of anti-ragging.

The street play was performed by the student council members which described two scenarios of ragging victims, one where the victim quit and the other where the victim sought help, hence, the students were encouraged to seek help when faced ragging. The play depicted the importance of standing up for self and encouraged students to seek help from the anti-ragging committee when faced ragging.

Through the play the student council conveyed a strong message with the slogan 'Break the silence, stand out, stop ragging before it starts'





The flash mob was a dramatic expression of the agony and the pain of the victims which explained the students the disaster caused due to ragging. Later, the anti-ragging committee teachers, through their speech assured the students that ragging will not be tolerated and the guilty would face immediate consequences.

The anti-ragging committee introduces its members to the students and encouraged the students to approach the committee when they face issues of ragging.

The programme was successfully organised to create awareness about anti-ragging and concluded with the slogan, 'Stand up for yourself because ragging is not fun but a crime'.
