

Report on EXPERT TALK on 'CATALYSING CHANGE AND UNLOCKING THE POTENTIAL OF INDIA'S INNOVATION AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP'


Celebrating India's Presidency of the G20, the Department of Economics and Political Science in association with Institution's Innovation Council, organised an Expert Talk on 'Catalysing Change and Unlocking the Potential of India's Innovation and Entrepreneurship' on 24th June 2023 from 10:00 am -11:30 am in the Seminar Hall.

The Resource Person was Ms. Teena Paul, Founder and CEO, Giftolexia Solutions Private Limited and Member, Civil 20 working group on disability.

She began the session by explaining about the origin of G20, an inter-governmental forum, it's purpose as a premium forum for international economic co-operation and it's focus on all major international issues. In her talk she included topics on the Startup20 engagement group, the importance of Startups in India and across G20, the focus areas and environment for startup growth, the Civil20 to address issues faced by civil society and the Digital Innovation Alliance. She summarised by saying that India's focus on startups during its G20 presidency is due to its transformative power of entrepreneurship and innovation which can drive the economy towards progress and sustainability for India and also globally. And, India also plans to continue support to startups beyond the G20 presidency because of the importance startups play in economic growth.

The speaker then conducted an activity for the students, dividing them into six groups, of which three groups discussed about setting up an incubation centre in college and the other three groups discussed about ways to create awareness about Dyslexia. This was followed by a panel discussion with leaders from all the groups. She then highlighted the importance of innovative, unique ideas and opportunities for startups.

The focus of the session was on the theme of India's G20 Presidency highlighting the role of Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Start-up to achieve the goals. The presentation was insightful and enriching and the students gained valuable knowledge and information. There were about 102 students of the BA stream. 








Your overall rating of the session 102 responses
