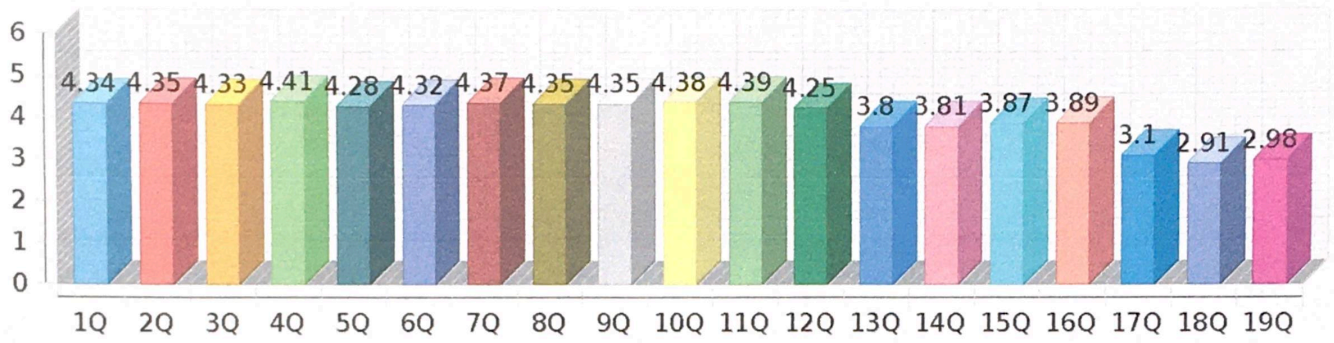

10. The lowest is the quality of food and service at the cafeteria at 2.91

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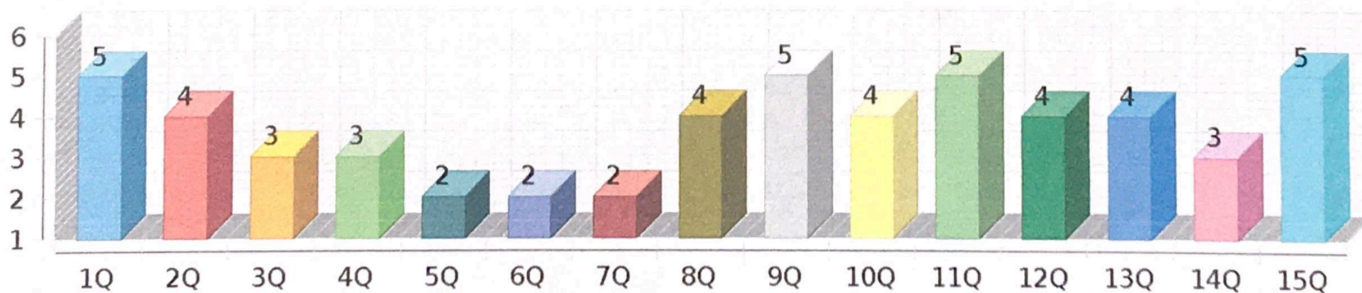

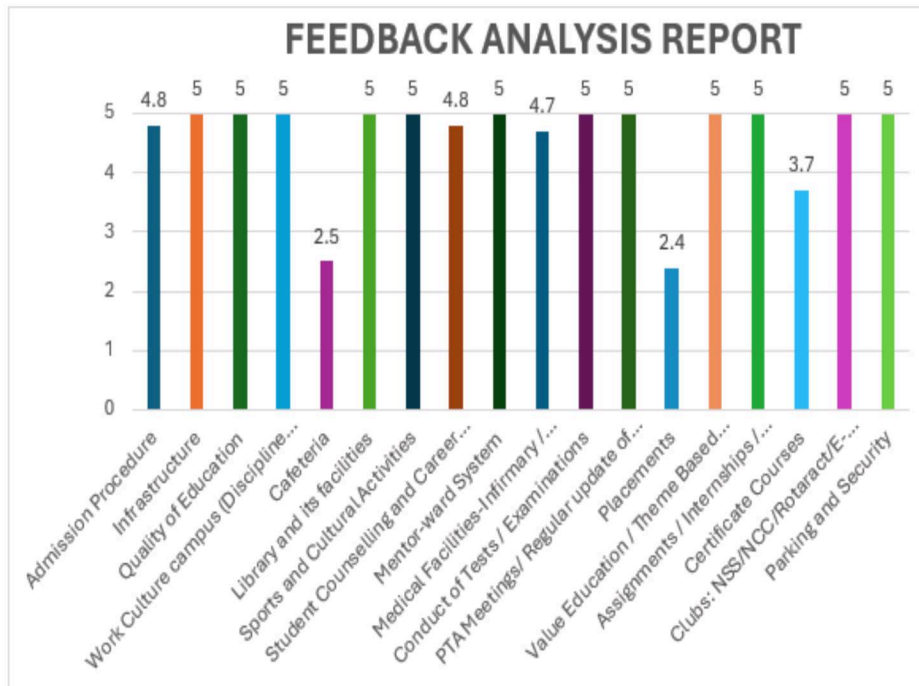
