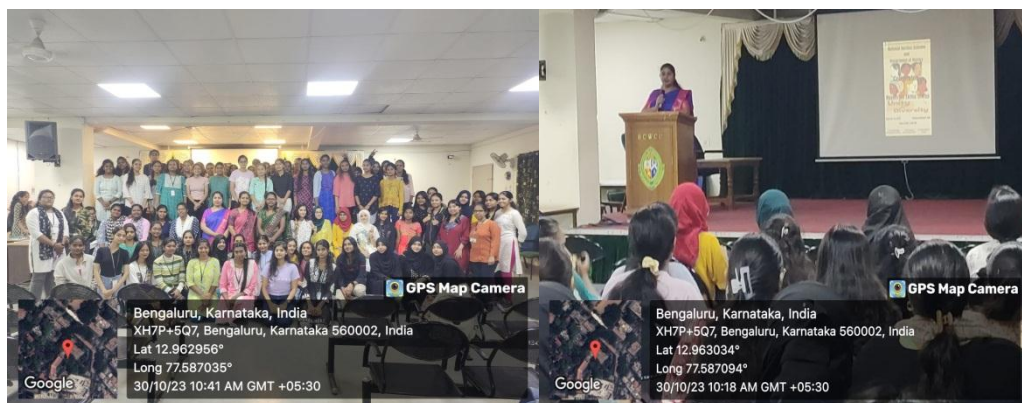
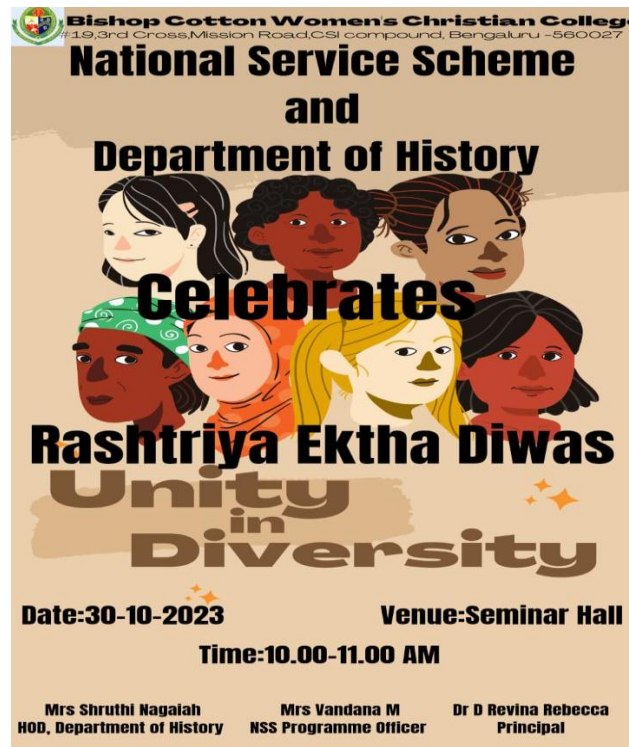


DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

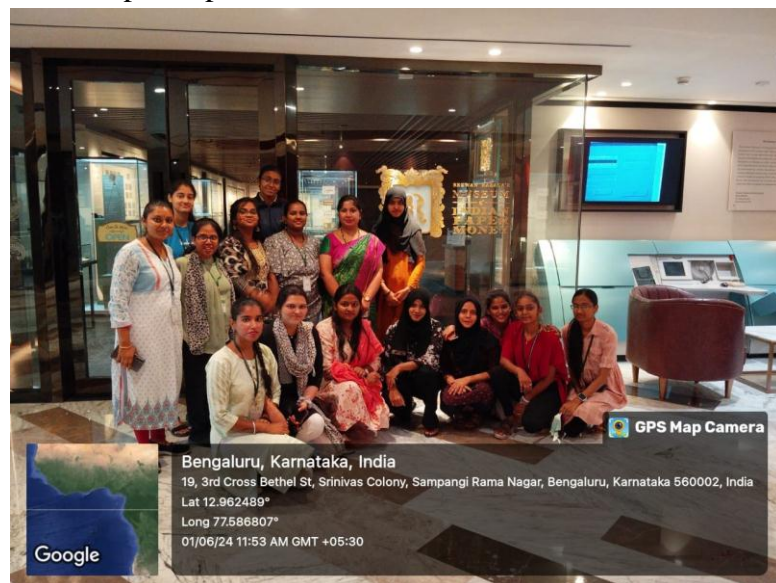

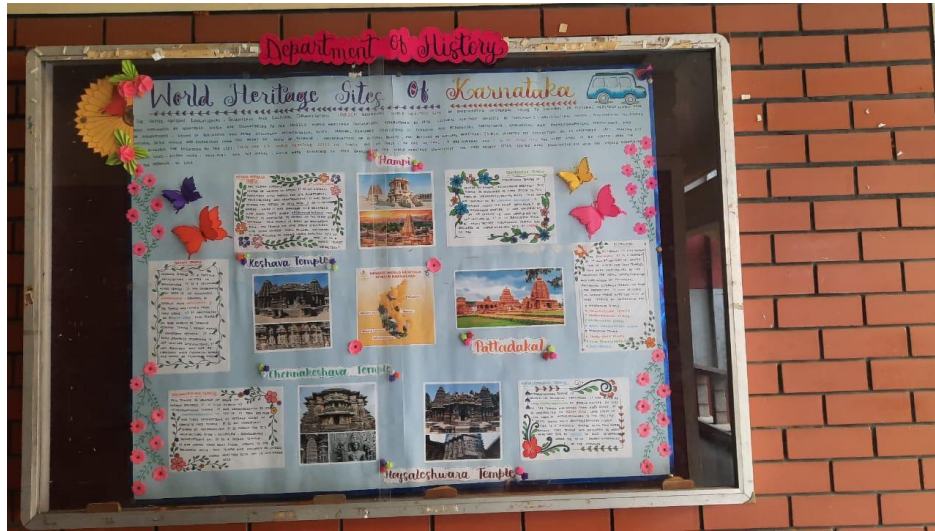
