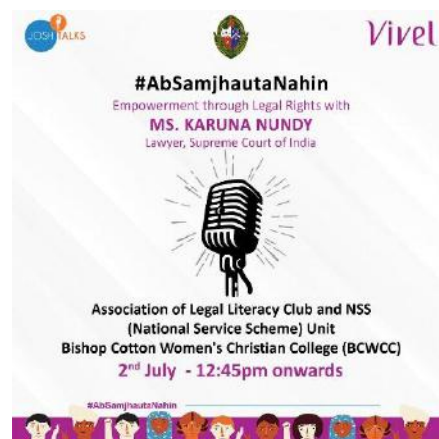
Webinar:
